Collections

Child support is an important source of financial help for low income families, lifting over a million children and adults out of poverty nationwide per year.





\$1.16 Billion (63%) of all child support payments collected in Ohio come from Employers through income withholdings.

Paternities

The child support program established



paternity for 50,412 children in FFY21.

Cost Effectiveness

Ohio's Child Support program is very cost effective, collecting \$6.35 for every \$1 expended, which is higher than the national average of \$5.39.

Spent = \$1

Collected = \$6.35

The Child Support program reduces or avoids the need for other public programs by recovering costs and by reducing or eliminating the need for public assistance programs.
