



# WHAT ARE MY HEALTH INSURANCE OPTIONS IN OHIO?

## MEDICAID

Age 19-64 and not on Medicare.  
Children up to 18, pregnant women and Medicare enrollees may also be eligible under different income rules.

## MARKETPLACE

Not on Medicare or Medicaid.  
Non-Citizens who are lawfully present may also qualify.  
*\*Private insurance may also be purchased directly through plans or insurance agents/brokers.*

## MEDICARE

Eligible for Social Security or railroad retirement benefits. You must be at least 65, have received Social Security Disability for two years or have end-stage kidney disease.

You may qualify if you're a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident for five years who is...



**What are my income limits?**

Family of 1 - under \$1,415/month  
Family of 4 - under \$2,904/month

Financial help is available for:  
Family of 1 - under \$4,163  
Family of 3 - under \$7,110

Financial help is available for:  
Family of 1 - under \$1,406  
Family of 2 - under \$1,903



**What does it cover?**

Doctor visits, hospital services, medication, free health screenings, mental health/substance abuse treatment, dental, vision and more.

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Part A: Hospital and nursing home care  
Part B: Office visits, screenings, supplies  
Part D: Medication



**How much will it cost?**

Nothing; it's free.

The average discount is 67% off base price. 85% of Ohioans eligible for financial help.

Part A: Free for most.  
Part B: \$144.60/month  
Part D: Based on income and IRS tax filing status  
Financial help is available



**When can I sign up?**

All year long.

2020 Enrollment Period:  
11/01/19 - 12/15/19  
Plus Special Enrollment Periods

Part A & B: 01/01 - 03/31  
Part D or Advantage Plan: 10/15 - 12/07  
Plus Special Enrollment Periods
